Climate Change - Energy Workshop

Purpose

Focus

- Energy generation scheme(s) (e.g. solar farm), alternative opportunities for their development (location and business case), to generate energy sustainably and economically on a community scale
- Bulk purchasing opportunities, for example insulation, solar panels.
 Efficiency of public buildings
- Improving Energy Efficiency of public buildings

Considerations

- Alternative business models such as
 - The Octopus scheme
 - Private business co-operative with members contributing to the cost and sharing the benefits
 - Parish Council develops a scheme, and uses the financial reward to invest in the Parish
