Community Services and Facilities Workshop

 - Electric EV charge points
 - Digital and internet services suitable for 2030s living
 - Public toilet.

The workshop shall address the following which West Berkshire Council and the Examiner may wish to see have been considered.

- Encouraging healthy lifestyles and reduce health inequalities
- Promoting regular participation in sports /exercise/leisure opportunities
- Protecting local rural communities and rural ways of life
- Mitigation of the effects of an ageing population on community and health resources.
