Land and Street Scapes Workshop

Purpose

To develop options to maintain and strengthen local distinctiveness and sense of place that

- enhance the character and quality of the street and natural landscapes within the village
- conserve and enhance the character and quality of Stratfield Mortimer's rural landscapes.

Key Focus

- Design Guides and Codes
 - for new developments (housing, car parks, green spaces etc) in the Neighbourhood Plan
 - to address climate change higher temperatures and heavier rainfall.
 - development of individual street or areas within Stratfield Mortimer
- The guides, aims and policies set out in 'Living with Beauty' report.

Considerations

The Design Guides and Codes shall address the following which West Berkshire Council and the Examiner may wish to see have been considered.

- Protecting and enhancing the landscape character and scenic quality of the countryside within and adjoining the parish
- Maintaining and enhancing the character and distinctiveness of the Parish and village within and outside the settlement boundary?
- Delivering high and appropriate design that maintain and enhances local character yet encourage innovative design that sit comfortably within the local character.
- Protects and enhances natural landscapes within the villages, including recreational open space and strategic green corridors?
- Avoiding loss of tranquillity minimising and, where possible, improving on unacceptable levels of noise, light pollution, odour and vibration.

The workshop must consider the relevant questions and policies (NPPF & WBC) as set out in the paper 'Comparison of how the Stratfield Mortimer NP Objectives Accord with Sustainability Themes, Objectives, Plans and Policies'
